

# Rainy Day Play Scavenger Hunt

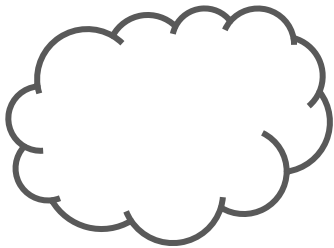

Take a walk around your backyard, neighborhood, or local park on a rainy day.

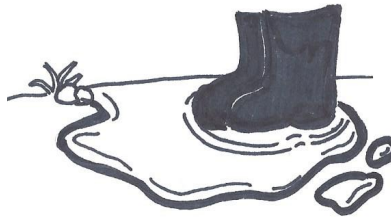
Look for these items and color them in!

Puddle



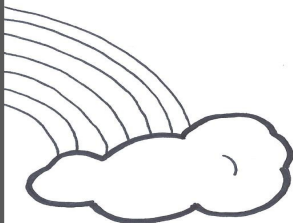
Rain creates puddles on hard surfaces like cement or compacted dirt.

Umbrella



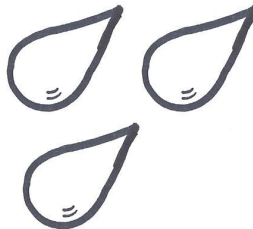
Umbrellas keep us dry. What other items do we use to stay dry?

Rainbow



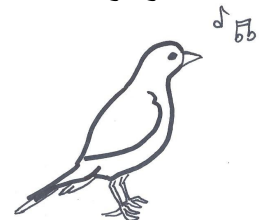
Rainbows are created when sun shines through raindrops in the sky.

Rain!



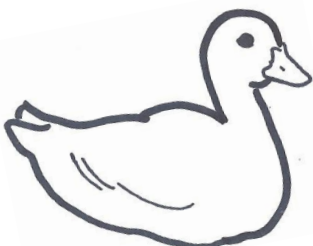
Turn your face up to the sky and enjoy the rain!

Singing Bird



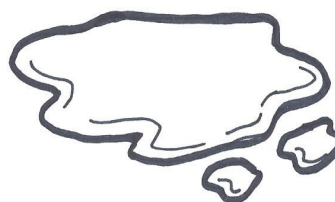
Some birds like to sing in the rain, just like some humans like to sing in the shower.

Ducks



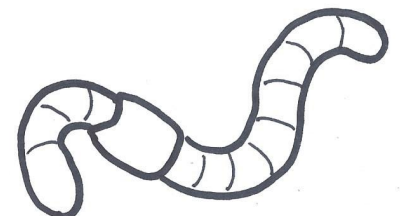
Duck feathers have special oils to repel water, just like a raincoat.
